We would like to present you a new issue of Electronic Journal, which continues to publish materials dedicated to the 75th anniversary of the Faculty of Economics of Lomonosov Moscow State University.

As well as in the last issue, we publish articles prepared by six departments of the Faculty of Economics.

The oldest department of the Faculty of Economics – the country's first Department of World Economics (until 2010, the Department of Economy of foreign countries), which was created in 1953 introduced an article dedicated to the research of the latest trends and developments of the world economy and global economic relations. Among the priority areas should be noted the following topics: "The globalization of the world economy and its impact on the socio-economic development of countries and regions of the world", "National innovation systems in foreign countries", "The problems of the modern world foreign exchange market", "import substitution", "Demographic and social problems of the world economy. "

The article of the Department of History of national economy and economic doctrines (thought) shows the formation and development of one of the leading departments of the Faculty of Economics of Moscow State University through its scientific achievements. The stages were selected, at each of which were improved a scientific-methodological approaches to the study of the history of economic thought and economic history. The result of the research process was the publication of fundamental monographs and textbooks at University level.

The article of the Department of Innovation Economics discusses new trends in the development of university education, involving the development of such areas as entrepreneurship and innovation in the university environment. The influence of the Russian state innovation policy on the formation of an innovative university policy is analyzed. Authors of the article considers the transformation of scientific schools and directions in the classical universities in conditions of formation of innovative economy based on old scientific schools. The necessity of training a new type of personnel adequate requirements of the knowledge economy and the role of the Department of Innovation Economics of Faculty of Economics of Lomonosov Moscow State University in the process.

The article of the Department of Agrarian Economy formulates the main features of the university agro-economic science – synthesis of theory and practice, a multidisciplinary approach, as well as extensive international links and cooperation. Briefly described the most important theoretical and practical developments of scientists of Moscow University in the agrarian economy. The achievements and history of

development of views in agroeconomic science are shown, the names of the researchers working on this issue are given.

Founded a little over three years ago, a dynamically developing department of industrial and competition policy of the Faculty of Economics has proposed an article that provides an overview of the theoretical and empirical aspects of price and tariff regulation in the gas sector, applied methods of regulation, the analysis of Russian practice, prospects of the gas industry in Russia and in the world, recommendations for the Russian authorities.

The works presented in this issue allow to get valuable information about the scientific life of the Faculty of Economics in different areas.
